## **BACKGROUND AND THEMES**

RIUL (Red de Universidades Lectoras / Network of Universities for Reading) has developed from its beginnings transversal and interdisciplinary lines of work around reading. In this context, social, environmental and patrimonial crises on a world scale are exemplified in an emblematic theme such as water, which should be understood not only as a resource but as part of a history and cultural memory, which is manifested in narratives, Arts, rites and other intangible heritage elements. It is necessary, therefore, to act in the educational and communication level to address the challenges and demands of the future by investigating the links between readings, ecology and education.

This congress intends to take stock and prospective of the water culture in the Spanish and Ibero-American context. It is presented as an open and multidisciplinary forum, open to teachers, researchers, experts and stakeholders. In particular, it aims to give value to literacy in these themes, underlining the importance of creating spaces and areas for literacy that help to solve the global challenges of the present and to empower people and communities. For all this, it will debate the theoretical paradigms and the practices concerning the water culture from a critical and holistic perspective, proposing initiatives and lines of action in this regard.

## CALL FOR PAPERS

### PAPERS: Deadline for submission of proposals of papers until February 28

It is necessary to be registered in the Congress to present papers. Each participant may submit up to two papers, as long as they belong to different themes. Each proposal may correspond to a maximum of three authors, of which at least one must make the registration in the Congress as communicator and the rest as assistants.

In order to present the papers (both in its oral and virtual modality) the title and a summary will be sent (250 words), also a short CV of the participant (200 words), to the e-mail [unilectoras.lee@gmail.com](mailto:unilectoras.lee@gmail.com).

Proposals will be evaluated by the Scientific Committee, which will inform the author his acceptance in a favorable case before March 10.

### Deadline for submission of full text until March 30

Once the paper has been accepted, the authors must send the complete text by the established date. This will not exceed 10 pages, written 1.5 spaces in New Times Roman font size 12. The paper will be evaluated by blind peers for subsequent publication in a volume in digital format with ISBN. Papers and outstanding papers will be published in a volume printed with ISBN (with the rules of publication for ÁLABE Journal:
